



COLORADO PRIMARY ELECTION SMART VOTING

June 30, 2026

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU VOTE

1 Candidates only – no ballot initiatives. This is a primary to determine which candidates appear on the November 3rd General Election ballot. There will be no Colorado ballot initiatives on this primary ballot.

2 Know your ballot type. Democrats and Republicans receive one ballot from their party. Unaffiliated voters receive two ballots — one for each party — but must **select just one to submit**. Candidates from the Unity Party and Libertarian Party appear on both ballots.

3 Multiple ways to vote. Ballots are mailed beginning **June 8th**. Return by mail, drop box, or in person at voting centers beginning **June 15th**. **Voter ID required**. Contact your local County Clerk for locations and times.

4 You're voting on a lot. Statewide races include Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, and Treasurer. You'll also vote on all 8 U.S. House members, one U.S. Senate member, all 65 State House members, and 21 State Senate members. Some ballots will include University of Colorado Regent and State Board of Education candidates.
